Although it is not suitable for guests who need to use a wheelchair, it is eminently suitable for anyone of limited mobility, using sticks or zimmer frames, or just need ground floor accommodation

The Station is set at the foot of a hill about half a mile off the A64 and sits, by itself, without neighbours, next to York -Scarborough railway line.



Arriving vehicles come through an open gate and swing left- then right handed into a gravelled car park. Vehicles can get within 1-2 metres of the stone slab path which leads to the front door of Platform 1.

The shower pod has an 11 inch lip, but that is the only lift from level throughout as there are no steps anywhere in Platform 1. Guests have easy access to the grounds and private courtyard.

If guests need disabled facilities in the toilet, we can provide both a surrounding frame and a raised seat, together with a seat in the shower on request.
